Bow Hill Blueberries is the oldest family-run blueberry farm in Western Washington's Skagit Valley. Today, the farm's legacy is carried forward by siblings Audrey and Ezra. With help from their young and growing families, they tend more than 6,000 heirloom blueberry bushes and their talented local harvest crew carefully handpicks the summer bounty at peak ripeness. Locals recount memories of picking berries at Bow Hill as far back as the 1940s—it was a first job for many, often to buy new clothes for the upcoming school year. By keeping the health of the environment and community at the heart of their business, Bow Hill is able to harvest more than 80,000 pounds of Certified Organic specialty fruit each season.
